EQUINE BIOSECURITY GUIDELINES

For Equestrian Owners











LOOK FOR SIGNS...REPORT SICK HORSES...PRACTICE BACKYARD BIOSECURITY!

- Avoid direct horse-to-horse contact.
- Monitor your horse for clinical signs of disease and report a temperature over 101.5° to a veterinarian.
- Avoid horse-to-human-horse contact.
- Avoid sharing equipment unless thoroughly cleaned and disinfected between uses.
- Avoid communal water sources.
- Any fever above 101.5° including neurological signs must be reported to the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
- Consult your local veterinarian for more useful tips.
