The City of Norco, in partnership with the Riverside County Transit Agency and with funds provided by Measure A, is pleased to provide transportation services to thousands of seniors since November of 2001. This door to door service allows seniors to maintain important social contact with their peers, and preserve their independence.



SENIOR SHUTTLE SERVICES

The "Seniors on the Move" program is a unique door-to-door transportation service that provides free transportation to Norco residents within a 30 mile radius outside of the Norco city limits. Trips include: medical appointments, prescription pick up, postal services, banking, bill paying, as well as transportation to and from the Norco Senior Center.
